

Because growing in the Lord is so important, those serving in ministry are required to attend a Sunday morning services on a regular basis.
After receiving the ministry schedule, a youth must call and make the Kid's ministry leader award if he/she cannot fulfill the designated ministry assignment (i.e.: will be absent, attend a different service, etc.) He or she may also be called upon at a moment's notice to serve in an un-scheduled area of ministry in a service, which he/she is attending.

List any gifts, callings, training, education or other factors that have prepared you for work with children/youth.

Policies and Procedures:

- Arrive at least 30 minutes before your scheduled time and remain to help clean and organize
- Check in with the children's ministry overseer when you arrive.
- Wear your T-Shirt and name tag when you are serving.
- Learn the names of the children and teachers, and pray for them weekly.
- While serving, make sure to fellowship with the children and not other youth volunteers.
- Ask the teacher how you can be of help and also take the initiative to notice ways to help like cleaning, assisting kids with craft, etc.
- Sit with the children to help with crowd control and to remind them to listen and stay on task.
- Do not carry any children if you are less than 13 years of age. Work with them at the tables or on the floor.
- Make sure there is always an adult with you in the classroom.
- Please communicate with Tony Cintron 585-709-5976 when you are unavailable to serve.
- If you believe there is already enough help in the classroom or area where you are serving, talk to the overseer to see where else you may be of help.
- Be actively walking with the Lord in your daily life so you can be a godly example for the children.
- Actively pursue growing and maturing in Christ. Read your Bible daily, attend church regularly, and engage in godly fellowship.
- Have fun & share the love of Christ with these sweet little ones.
- **No Electronics.** Servants must refrain from using or having electronics out during the complete time you are schedule to serve, i.e. cellphones, mp3 players, tablets, etc.
